AN ACT to provide in part for the expenditures of government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. In order to provide for certain acts

- 2 and resolves of the legislature requiring the payment
- 3 of money from the treasury, and also to provide for
- 4 the necessary expenditures of government for the cur-
- 5 rent fiscal year, the following sums are hereby appro-
- 6 priated out of any moneys in the treasury; and the
- 7 governor, with the advice and consent of the council,
- 8 is hereby authorized, at any time prior to the first day
