IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
FIFTY-SIX.

AN ACT to provide in part for the expenditures of
government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. In order to provide for certain acts
2 and resolves of the legislature requiring the payment
3 of money from the treasury, and also to provide for
4 the necessary expenditures of government for the cur-
5 rent fiscal year, the following sums are hereby appro-
6 priated out of any moneys in the treasury ; and the
7 governor, with the advice and consent of the council,
8 is hereby authorized, at any time prior to the first day

9 of January, eighteen hundred and fifty-seven, to draw
10 his warrant upon the treasury for the same :

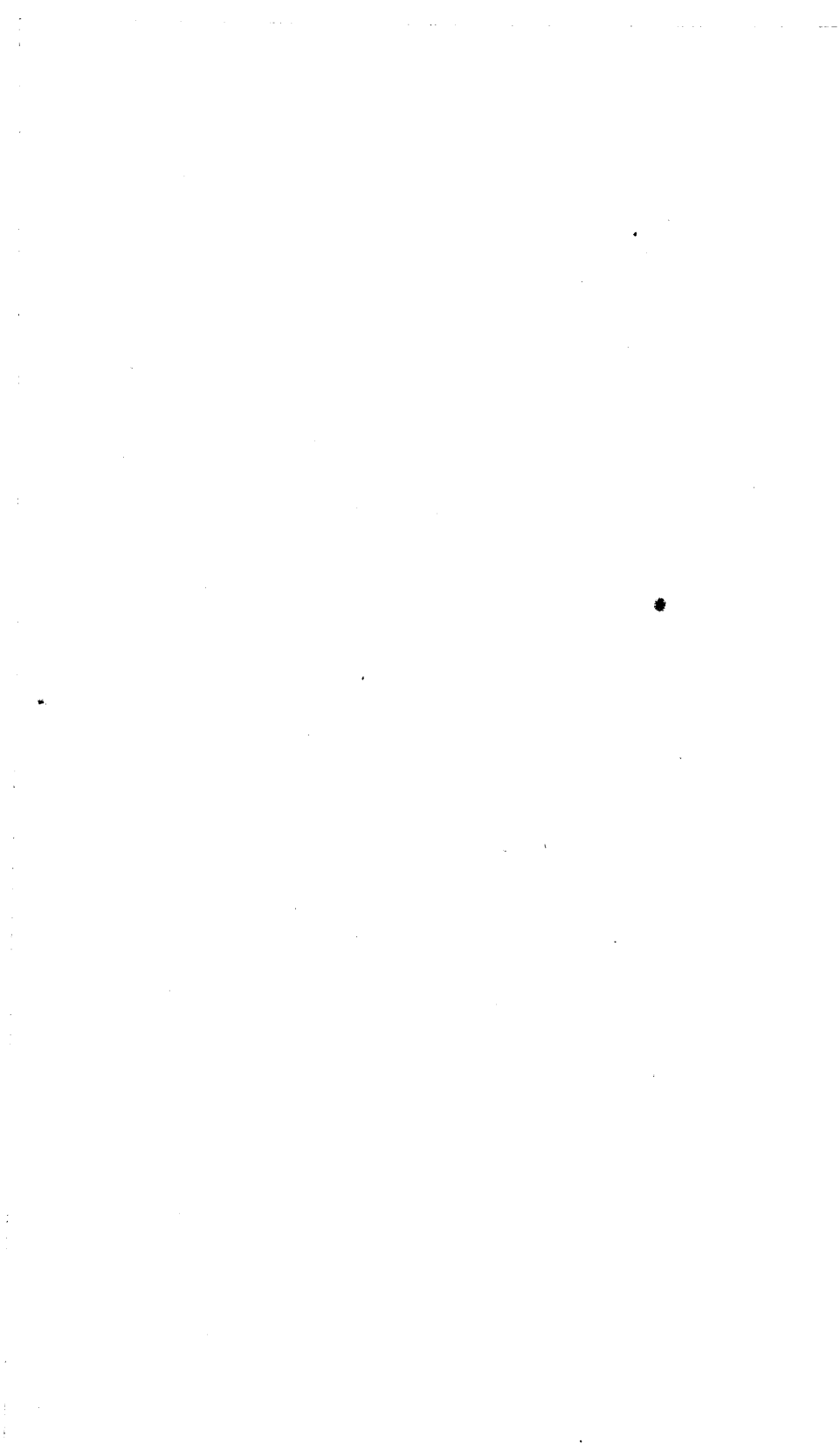
