RESOLVE laying a tax on the counties.

---

*Resolved,* That the sums annexed to the counties contained in the following schedule are hereby granted as a tax for each county respectively, to be appropriated, assessed, collected and applied for the purpose of paying the debts and necessary expenses of the same and other purposes ordered by law, to wit:

- 7 Androscoggin, ten thousand dollars.  
8 Aroostook, two thousand nine hundred and fifty dol-  
9 lars.  
10 Cumberland, thirty-two thousand dollars.  
11 Franklin, three thousand five hundred and seventy-  
12 five dollars.  
13 Hancock, seven thousand dollars.

- 14 Kennebec, eighteen thousand dollars.
- 15 Lincoln, twelve thousand dollars.
- 16 Oxford, nine thousand five hundred dollars.
- 17 Penobscot, twenty-five thousand dollars.
- 18 Piscataquis, one thousand nine hundred dollars.
- 19 Sagadahoc, eight thousand dollars.
- 20 Somerset, five thousand dollars.
- 21 Waldo, nine thousand dollars.
- 22 York, twenty-one thousand seven hundred dollars.
- 23 Washington, eleven thousand dollars.
