STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FIFTY-SIX.

AN ACT in further regulation of the process of foreign attachment.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. No person shall be adjudged a trustee, 2 by reason of any amount, not exceeding twenty dol-3 lars, due from him to the principal defendant as wages 4 for his personal labor for a time not exceeding one 5 month next previous to the service of the writ upon 6 the supposed trustee. But this provision shall not be 7 applicable to suits brought for the recovery of any 8 sum due for necessaries furnished within six months

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9 next preceding the date of service upon the supposed10 trustee.

SECT. 2. The sixth clause of the sixty-third section 2 of the one hundred and nineteenth chapter of the 3 revised statutes is hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall not apply to any suits pend-2 ing at the time this act shall take effect.
