AN ACT additional to an act additional to an act to in-  
corporate the Penobscot Log Driving Company.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
tives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The powers granted to the said com-  
pany are hereby enlarged and extended, so as to in-  
clude within the chartered limits thereof, the boom  
and piers, now in process of being erected at the  
head of Chesuncook lake, which are to become the  
property of said company, and all the expenses of  
erecting and completing the same, are to be assumed  
and borne by said company. It shall not be neces-  
sary to assess for such payment more than one-fourth

10 part in any one year, but whatever surplus funds re-  
11 main of the annual assessment shall be applied to the  
12 payment of said expenses in addition to the said one-  
13 fourth part.

SECT. 2. The company may assess a toll pursuant  
2 to the provisions of their charter, not exceeding one  
3 dollar for every thousand feet board measure of logs  
4 driven under the provisions of said act ; and all acts  
5 and parts of acts providing for any different rate of  
6 toll are hereby repealed, except that they shall re-  
7 main in force as to all tolls heretofore assessed and  
8 remaining uncollected.

SECT. 3. The directors may authorize the treasurer  
2 to give the company notes for the amount necessary  
3 to be raised to pay the expenses of erecting said  
4 boom and piers, for such sums and payable at such  
5 times as they direct. *Provided*, this act shall be ac-  
6 cepted by the said company at a meeting called for  
7 that purpose.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect from and after  
the date of its approval.
