STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND FIFTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT additional to an act entitled "An Act to authorize the consolidation of certain Railroad Corporations."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the ninth section of chapter six
2 hundred and fifty-one of the Special Laws of Maine,
3 entitled "An Act to authorize the consolidation of
4 certain Railroad Corporations" approved April 1,
5 1856, b2, and the same is hereby repealed; *Provided*,
6 *however*, that nothing *in this act* shall be construed to
7 exempt or relieve the corporation, that may be formed
8 under the act to which this is additional, from any
9 obligations, or duties respecting connections with

10 other railroad companies, which were imposed by
11 law upon either the Androscoggin and Kennebec
12 Railroad Company, or the Penobscot and Kennebec
13 Railroad Company, prior to the passage of the act to
14 which this act is additional.

SECT. 2. This act shall be in force from and after
2 its approval by the Governor.
