STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND FIFTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to provide in part for the Expenditures of
Government.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. In order to provide for several acts
2 and resolves of the legislature, requiring the payment
3 of money from the treasury, and also to provide for
4 the necessary expenditures of government for the
5 current fiscal year, the following sums are hereby ap-
6 propriated out of any moneys in the treasury ; and

7 the Governor, with advice and consent of the Council,
8 is hereby authorized, at any time prior to the first day
9 of January next, to draw his warrant upon the treas-
10 ury for the same :

11 *Public debt*, thirty thousand dollars, \$30,000 00

12 *Interest on public debt*, thirty-eight thou-

13 sand six hundred dollars, 38,600 00

14 *School fund No. 24*, seventy-five thousand

15 dollars, 75,000 00

16 *Interest on permanent school fund*, eight
