IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FIFTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to provide in part for the Expenditures of Government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section 1. In order to provide for several acts 2 and resolves of the legislature, requiring the payment 3 of money from the treasury, and also to provide for 4 the necessary expenditures of government for the

5 current fiscal year, the following sums are hereby ap6 propriated out of any moneys in the treasury; and

7 the Governor, with advice and consent of the Council, 8 is hereby authorized, at any time prior to the first day

9 of January next, to draw his warrant upon the treas-
