STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FIFTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT in relation to the Supreme Judicial Court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The act in relation to the Supreme 2 Judicial Court, approved April ninth, one thousand 3 eight hundred and fifty-six, is hereby repealed, and 4 all acts and parts of acts, repealed by said act are 5 hereby revived, excepting sections one, two and four 6 of the "Act additional concerning the Supreme Ju-

7 dicial Court and its Jurisdiction," approved March8 sixteenth, eighteen hundred and fifty-five.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after 2 its approval by the Governor.
