
In the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven.

AN ACT in relation to Wills.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. When a legacy is directed to be paid by
- 2 executors or trustees to a person or corporation, upon
- 3 conditions first to be performed, by the person or
- 4 corporation; and no time is stated in the will, or in
- 5 the charter or by-laws of the corporation, within
- 6 which the conditions are to be performed, a reasona-
- 7 ble time, not exceeding five years from the date of
- 8 this act, or from the probate of the will proved subse-

9 quently to this act, is allowed therefor; and if not so 10 performed within that time, it shall be administered 11 as an undivised estate, unless otherwise disposed of 12 by the will.
