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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND FIFTY-SEVEN.

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### AN ACT in relation to Wills.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. When a legacy is directed to be paid by  
2 executors or trustees to a person or corporation, upon  
3 conditions first to be performed, by the person or  
4 corporation; and no time is stated in the will, or in  
5 the charter or by-laws of the corporation, within  
6 which the conditions are to be performed, a reasona-  
7 ble time, not exceeding five years from the date of  
8 this act, or from the probate of the will proved subse-

9 quently to this act, is allowed therefor; and if not so  
10 performed within that time, it shall be administered  
11 as an undivided estate, unless otherwise disposed of  
12 by the will.
