STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FIFTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT in relation to Attachments of Real Estate and Personal Property.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. In all attachments, and copies of returns,

- 2 and certificates filed in the office of the register of
- 3 deeds, or in the office of the clerk of any town, of
- 4 real estate, and of personal property, which by reason
- 5 of its bulk or other special cause, could not be imme-
- 6 diately removed, heretofore or hereafter made, stating
- 7 the sums sued for in the writ, it shall be sufficient

8 evidence that the office, has complied with the requisi9 tions of law in relation to the statement of the sums
10 sued for, if it appears that he has stated as the sums
11 sued for, either the amount ordered to be attached in
12 the writ, the ad damnum, or the amount of the de13 mands described in the writ. This section shall apply
14 in all suits, actions and proceedings in law or equity
15 now pending or hereafter commenced.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect from and after 2 its approval by the Governor.
