#### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FIFTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT entitled an act to incorporate the Portland and New York Steamship Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Joseph W. Dyer, Allen Haines, John

- 2 B. Coyle, John Sparrow, Cyrus Sturdevant and Wil-
- 3 liam Kimball, their associates and successors, are
- 4 hereby constituted a body politic and corporate by the
- 5 name of the Portland and New York Steamship Com-
- 6 pany, for the purpose of running steam packets be-
- 7 tween the cities of Portland and New York, with all
- 8 the powers and privileges, and subject to all the

- 9 duties and liabilities provided by the general laws of 10 this state, respecting like corporations.
  - Sect. 2. The capital stock of said corporation shall
  - 2 not be less than fifty thousand dollars, nor more than
  - 3 two hundred thousand dollars, divided into shares of
  - 4 one hundred dollars each.
    - Sect. 3. The said company are hereby authorized
  - 2 to purchase and hold such real and personal estate as
  - 3 may be necessary to effect the object of their incor-
  - 4 poration.
