STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
FIFTY-EIGHT.

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AN ACT entitled an act to incorporate the Portland and  
New York Steamship Company.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Joseph W. Dyer, Allen Haines, John  
2 B. Coyle, John Sparrow, Cyrus Sturdevant and Wil-  
3 liam Kimball, their associates and successors, are  
4 hereby constituted a body politic and corporate by the  
5 name of the Portland and New York Steamship Com-  
6 pany, for the purpose of running steam packets be-  
7 tween the cities of Portland and New York, with all  
8 the powers and privileges, and subject to all the

9 duties and liabilities provided by the general laws of  
10 this state, respecting like corporations.

SECT. 2. The capital stock of said corporation shall  
2 not be less than fifty thousand dollars, nor more than  
3 two hundred thousand dollars, divided into shares of  
4 one hundred dollars each.

SECT. 3. The said company are hereby authorized  
2 to purchase and hold such real and personal estate as  
3 may be necessary to effect the object of their incor-  
4 poration.
