AN ACT to establish salaries for County Commissioners.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. County commissioners shall receive from  
2 the treasuries of their several counties, the following  
3 salaries in quarterly payments, on the first day of  
4 January, April, July and October, of each year, com-  
5 mencing July first, eighteen hundred and fifty-eight :  
6 The commissioners of the county  
7 of Androscoggin, dollars ;  
8 of Aroostook, dollars ;  
9 of Cumberland, dollars ;  
10 of Franklin, dollars ;

11 of Hancock,	dollars ;
12 of Kennebec,	dollars ;
13 of Lincoln,	dollars ;
14 of Oxford,	dollars ;
15 of Penobscot,	dollars ;
16 of Piscataquis,	dollars ;
17 of Sagadahoc,	dollars ;
18 of Somerset,	dollars ;
19 of Waldo,	dollars ;
20 of Washington,	dollars ;
21 of York,	dollars ;

SECT. 2. No fees, costs, compensation or emoluments whatever, shall be allowed or paid from the treasury of any county to any commissioner thereof, except the salary aforesaid, which shall be in full for all travel, expenses and services of any kind and description, directly or indirectly rendered by him to said county, whether as commissioner or otherwise.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect on the first day of April next, and sections twelve, thirteen and fourteen, of the seventy-eighth chapter of the revised statutes and all other acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.
