Speaker of the House of Representatives:

In answer to an order of the House of Representatives of the 23th January; also to another of the 18th February, instant, I have the honor herewith to submit the following Schedules marked A, B, C, and D, embracing the information therein called for. Schedule A, embraces a list of the townships and tracts sold and paid for since A. D. 1850. Lands conveyed under grants since 1850, are embraced in Schedule B; and those conveyed by Massachusetts to W. H. McCrillis, et als., by deed dated September 1, 1853, are embraced in Schedule C. In Schedule D, are embraced the lands leased without limitation of time, by Massachusetts, to parties, prior to Maine's purchase of the Massachusetts lands in 1853.

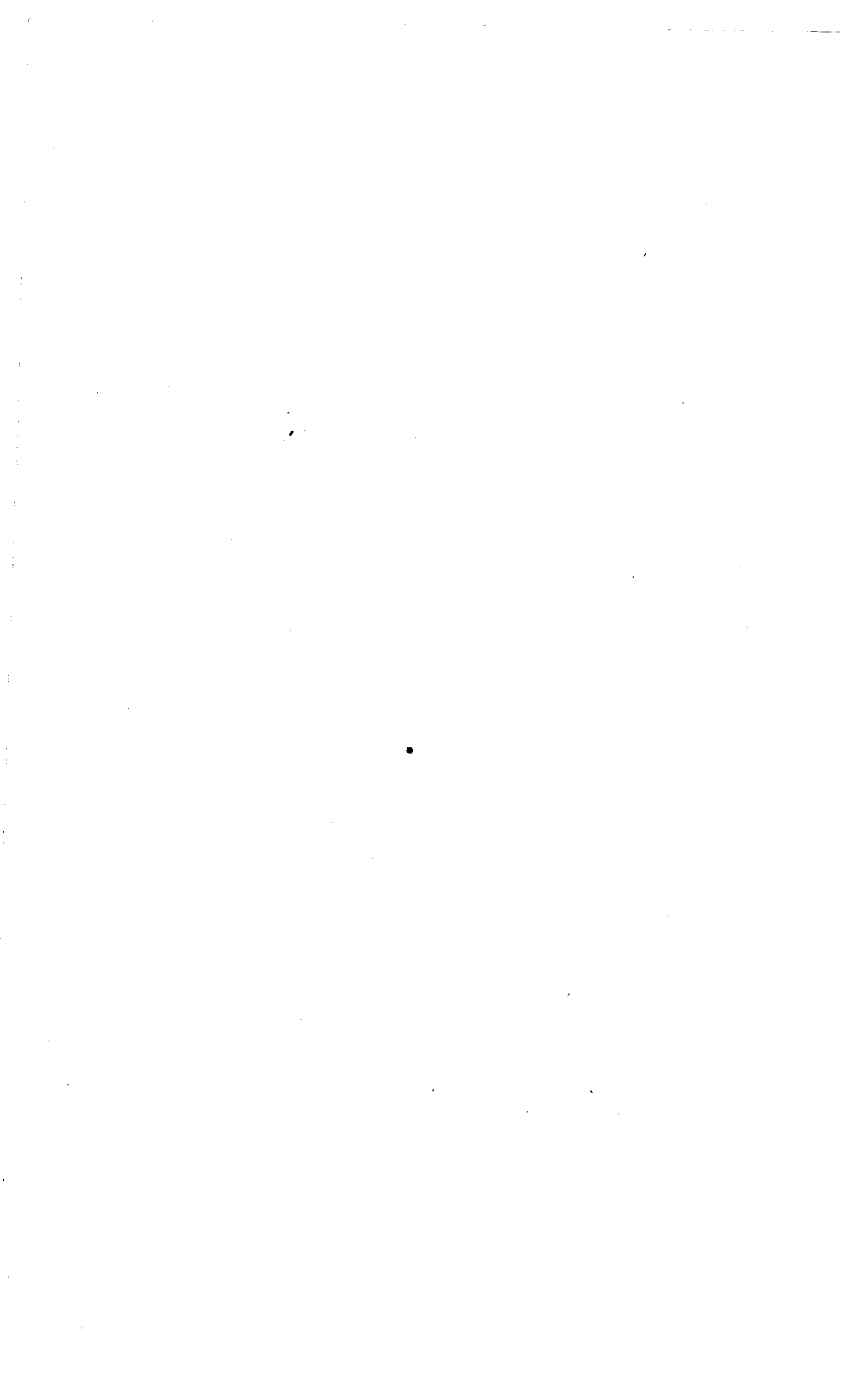
