STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY.

AN ACT authorizing the Somerset and Kennebec Railroad to extend their road into the county of Piscataquis.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Somerset and Kennebec Railroad 2 Company is hereby authorized to extend their railroad 3 into the town of Athens, in the county of Somerset, 4 and from thence to or across the Piscataquis river, and 5 from thence to any point or points within the county 6 of Piscataquis the directors of said company may fix 7 and determine; and for this purpose said company 8 are hereby authorized to exercise all the powers and

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9 are vested with all the rights, privileges and immuni10 ties, and are subject to all the liabilities, duties, obli11 gations and restrictions granted or imposed by their
12 act of incorporation approved August tenth, eighteen
13 hundred and forty-eight.

SECT. 2. Said company may locate said road to or 2 across said river, within three years, and from thence 3 as aforesaid within five years from the passage of this 4 act; and the term of ten years from the passage of 5 this act is allowed them to finish and complete the 6 same.
