IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND SIXTY.

AN ACT authorizing the Somerset and Kennebec Rail-
road to extend their road into the county of Piscataquis.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The Somerset and Kennebec Railroad
2 Company is hereby authorized to extend their railroad
3 into the town of Athens, in the county of Somerset,
4 and from thence to or across the Piscataquis river, and
5 from thence to any point or points within the county
6 of Piscataquis the directors of said company may fix
7 and determine; and for this purpose said company
8 are hereby authorized to exercise all the powers and

9 are vested with all the rights, privileges and immuni-
10 ties, and are subject to all the liabilities, duties, obli-
11 gations and restrictions granted or imposed by their
12 act of incorporation approved August tenth, eighteen
13 hundred and forty-eight.

SECT. 2. Said company may locate said road to or
2 across said river, within three years, and from thence
3 as aforesaid within five years from the passage of this
4 act; and the term of ten years from the passage of
5 this act is allowed them to finish and complete the
6 same.
