IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND SIXTY.

AN ACT authorizing minor children to deposit money in  
savings banks, and making the same their own property.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

A minor has the right to deposit with, or loan money  
2 to any savings bank, in the mode authorized by law,  
3 and the money so deposited or loaned by such minor  
4 is not the property or credit of the parents of such  
5 minor, or either of them, during the life time of said  
6 minor, but of the minor; and the minor has the power  
7 to control, manage and dispose of the same, with the  
8 same remedies by the appropriate form of action as  
9 persons may, who have attained their full age of  
10 majority.
