STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-TWO.

AN ACT to suspend certain provisions in chapter fortyseven of the revised statutes concerning banks.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The provisions contained in chapter
- 2 forty-seven of the revised statutes imposing penalties
- 3 and liabilities upon banking corporations and stock-
- 4 holders therein for refusal to redeem their bills, checks.
- 5 or drafts in specie, are hereby suspended until the
- 6 tenth day of January next; provided, however, that if
- 7 before that time, the Boston banks shall resume specie
- 8 payment, then in that event, the banks in this State
- 9 are to resume also; anything in this act to the con-
- 10 trary notwithstanding.

- SECT. 2. During the suspension authorized in the 2 preceding section, said banking corporations shall 3 upon demand pay or tender payment of their bills, 4 checks or drafts in such bank bills as are at the time 5 received as currency by the banks in Boston at their 6 par value.
- SECT. 3. This act shall take effect forthwith upon 2 its approval by the governor.
