IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-TWO.

AN ACT to provide in part for the expenditures of government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. In order to provide for several acts and 2 resolves of the legislature, requiring the payment of 3 money from the treasury, and also to provide for the 4 necessary expenditures of government for the current 5 fiscal year, the following sums are hereby appropriated 6 out of any moneys in the treasury; and the governor 7 with advice and consent of the council, is hereby au-8 thorized at any time prior to the first day of January


