IN THE YEAR, OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to amend chapter six, section twenty-eight of the revised statutes, relating to assessment of taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Chapter six, section twenty-eight of the
- 2 revised statutes, is hereby amended by striking there-
- 3 from the words—"one eighth part of the whole tax;
- 4 and if such proportion, in any case, exclusive of high-
- 5 way taxes to be paid by the polls, exceeds one dollar
- 6 to each poll, it shall be reduced to that sum"—and
- 7 inserting in lieu thereof the words: two dollars to each
- 8 poll.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved
- 2 by the governor.
