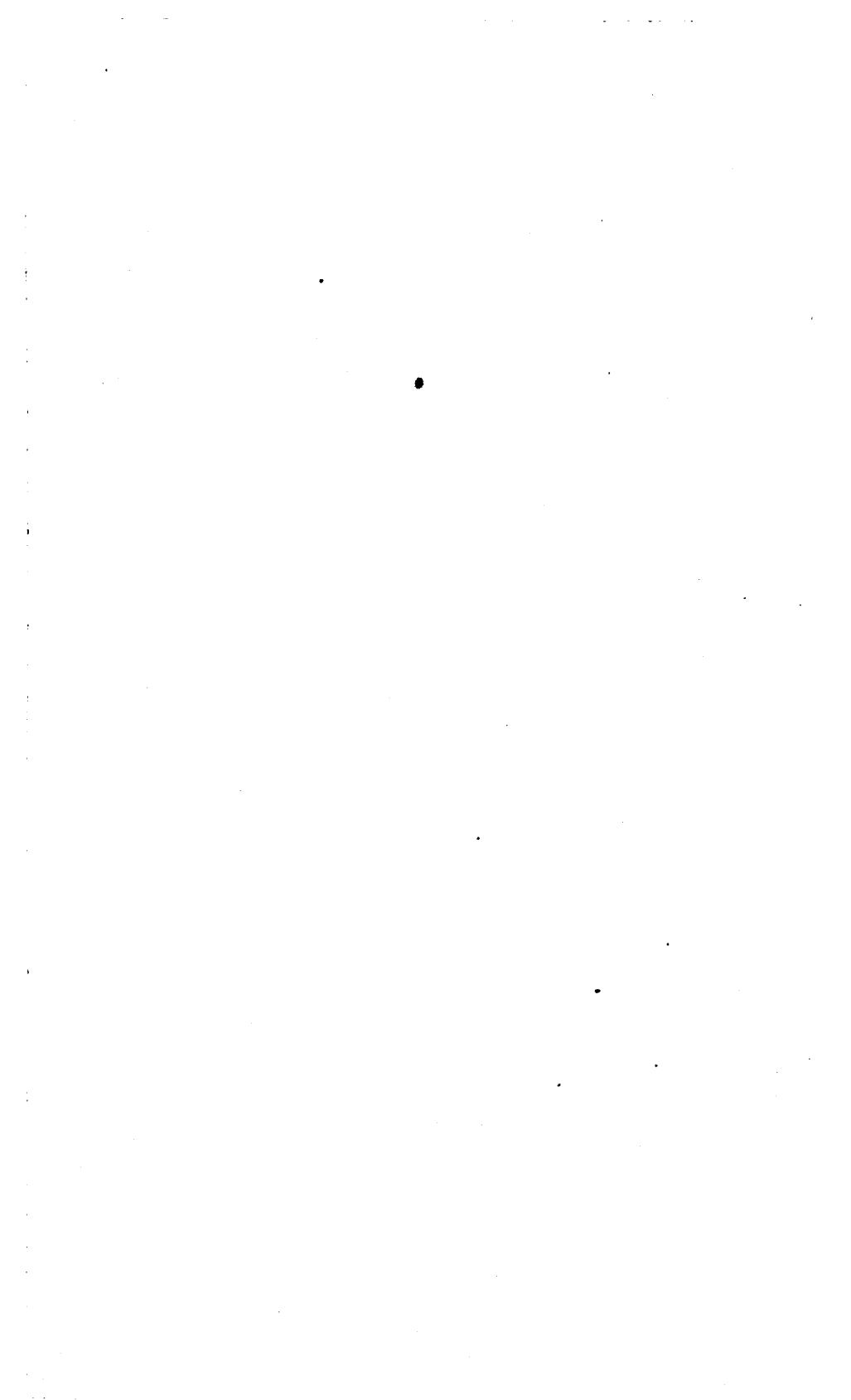

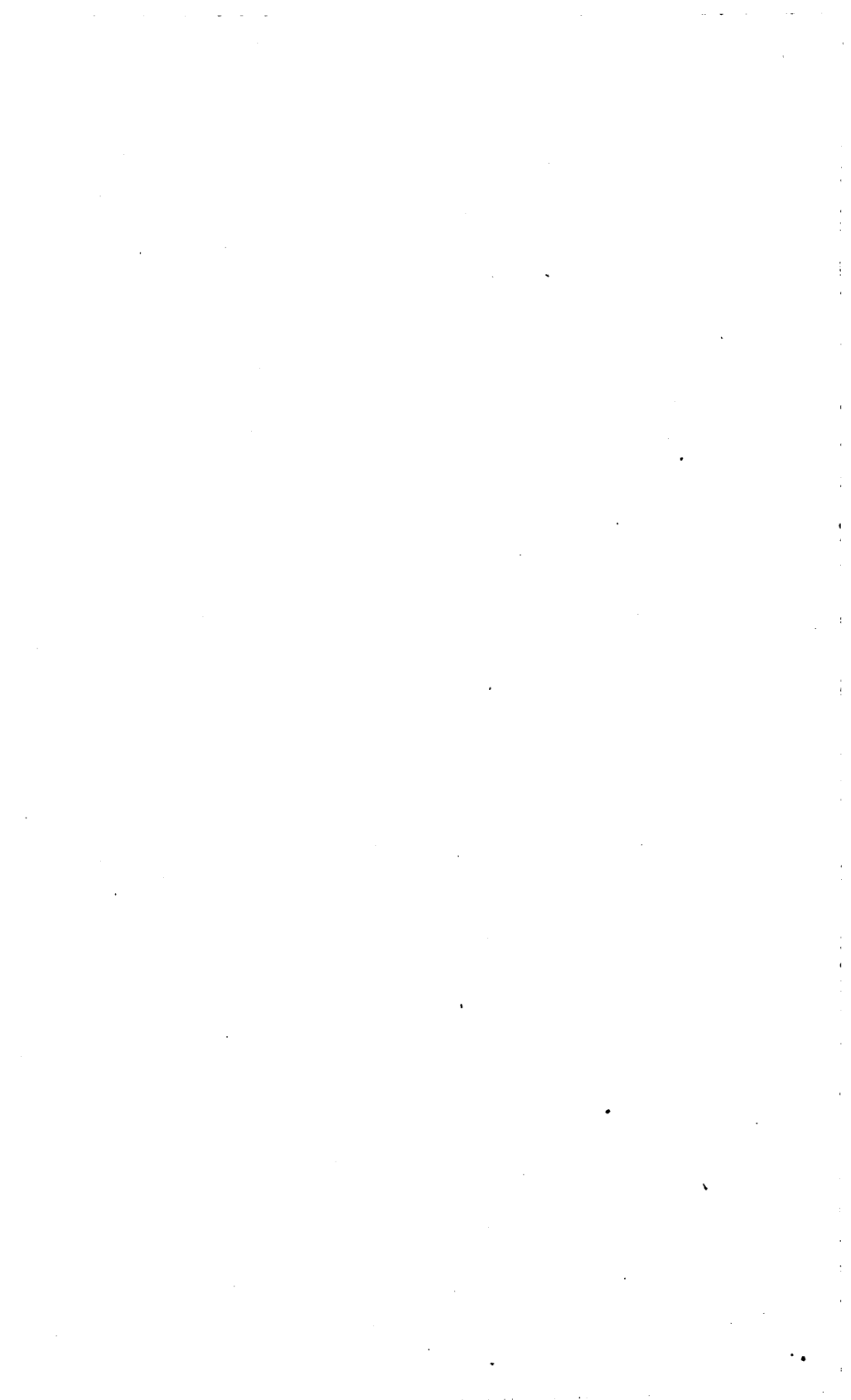

AMENDMENT OF RESOLVES IN FAVOR OF WESTBROOK SEMINARY.

Strike out all after “resolve” to the word “provided” in thirteenth line and insert:

That the land agent under the instructions of the
2 governor and council be and he is hereby directed to
3 sell the timber and lumber upon any one half township
4 of land belonging to the state, not already selected for
5 the permanent school fund, and not otherwise appro-
6 priated, after advertising for six months in the state
7 paper, in the paper nearest to where the land is situ-
8 ated, and in the Bangor Daily Whig and Courier, to
9 receive at the land office sealed proposals for the tim-
10 ber and lumber on said one half township of land in
11 one eighth sections, and the purchasers to have ten
12 years to take off said timber and lumber and no longer.
13 A record of the proposals shall be made and kept in
14 the land office, which shall be open to any one after
15 the day of sale. The proceeds of said sale not exceed-
16 ing ten thousand dollars net, shall be by him paid to
17 the trustees of Westbrook Seminary.
