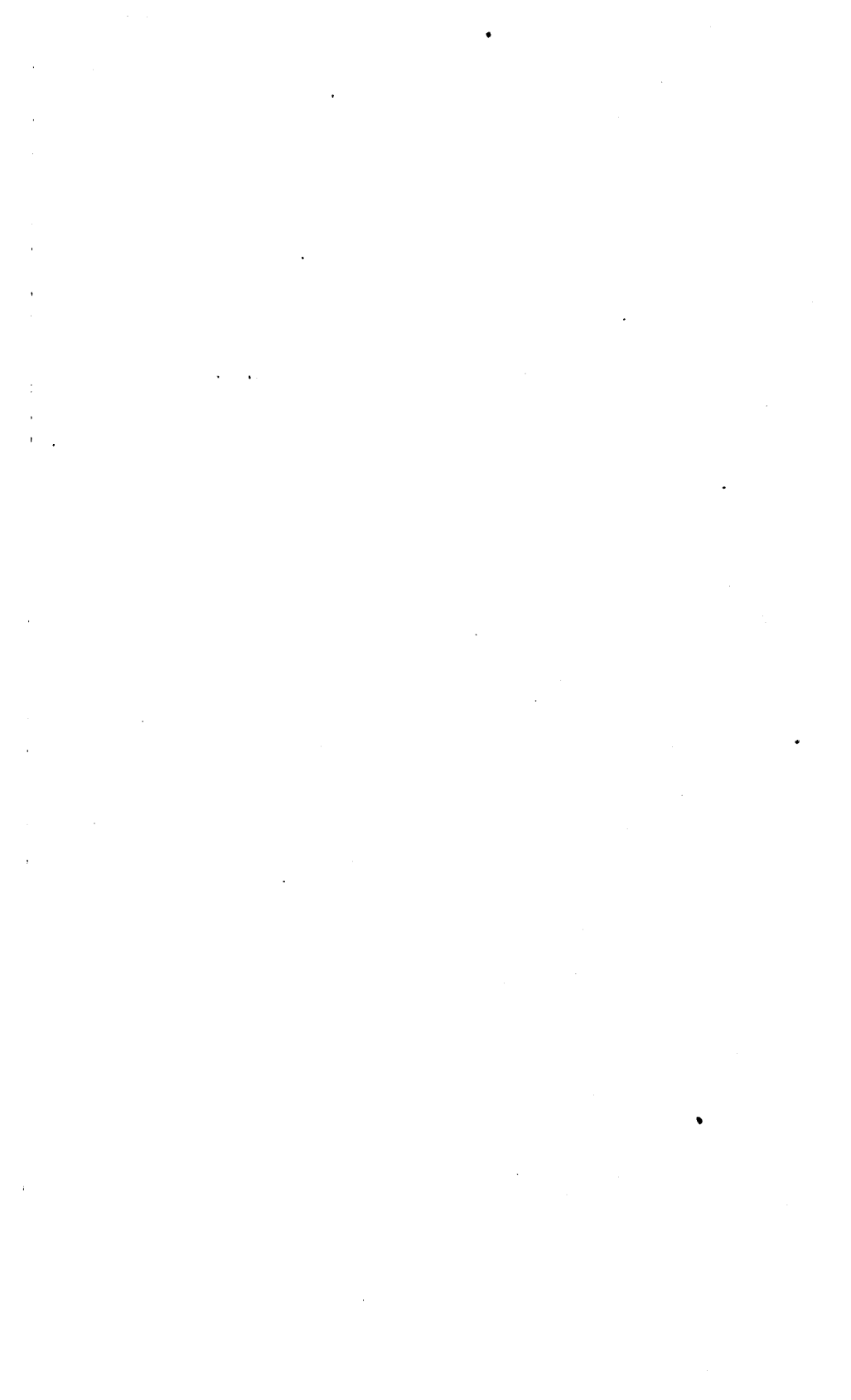

AMENDMENT PROPOSED BY MR. SPRING

TO BILL "AN ACT IN ADDITION TO SECTION SEVEN OF CHAPTER ONE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-FIVE OF THE REVISED STATUTES IN
REFERENCE TO PROCEEDINGS IN CAPITAL CASES."

Amend by striking out section two of said bill and insert the following :

SECT. 2. The warrant mentioned in section seven of
2 said chapter, shall be issued immediately after the
3 expiration of the year, unless the governor and council
4 after a full examination of the case shall be of the
5 opinion that it should be stayed ; and in such case
6 they may determine whether the convict shall continue
7 in solitary confinement after, or shall be employed like
8 other prisoners.
