Remarks.

By an act of the Legislature approved January sixteenth, eighteen hundred and sixty-six, the act to continue in force the suspension of specie payments, is further continued until the fifteenth day of January, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, provided banking corporations shall, upon demand, pay or tender payment of their bills, checks or drafts, in lawful money of the United States.
