STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in relation to taxation of United States bonds.

WHEREAS, it is one of the first essentials of a good

- 2 government, that it avoid all unnecessary causes of
- 3 discontent among its subjects, and as far as possible to
- 4 remove such causes when they already exist, and
- 5 Whereas, all legislation whose effect is to discrimi-
- 6 nate in favor of one class, thereby imposing unequal
- 7 burdens upon another class, is properly to be reckoned
- 8 among such causes of discontent; therefore,

Resolved, That this legislature recognizing the princi-

- 2 ple above declared, instruct our senators and request
- 3 our representatives to use their diligent efforts to de-
- 4 vise some measure whereby, without prejudice to the
- 5 rights of any, the present inequality of taxation arising
- 6 from the exemption of United States bonds may be
- 7 removed.
