STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX.

AN ACT in relation to the rules of evidence in addition to "an act to amend section eighty-three of chapter eighty-two of the revised statutes relating to proceedings in court," approved March fifteenth, eighteen hundred sixty-two.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. In all actions in which an executor,

- 2 administrator or other legal representative of a de-
- 3 ceased person is a party, such executor, administrator
- 4 or representative party may offer himself as a witness
- 5 and testify to any facts, legally admissible upon the
- 6 general rules of evidence happening before the death
- 7 of the testator, intestate or deceased person; and when

- 8 such executor, administrator or representative party 9 so offers himself and testifies, the adverse party shall 10 neither be excluded nor excused from testifying in 11 reference to such facts.
 - Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with 2 the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.
