STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVES directing the manner of engrossing the acts
and resolves and for preserving the same.

Resolved, That from and after the present session of
2 the legislature, all acts and resolves passed to be en-
3 grossed in both branches of the legislature, in lieu of
4 being engrossed by writing as directed in a resolve
5 approved January eleventh, eighteen hundred and
6 twenty-two, shall be engrossed by printing in fair and
7 conspicuous type upon suitable paper, leaving margins
8 of sufficient width to bind the same into volumes of
9 uniform size and appearance with those heretofore
10 engrossed, bound and deposited in the office of the
11 secretary of state, and with blank lines or spaces in
12 each bill so passed and printed for original signatures
13 in writing, and dates of passage and approval of the

14 president of the senate, speaker of the house of repre-
15 sentatives and governor of the state.

Resolved, That the engrossing as herein directed,
2 shall continue to be done under the authority and su-
3 pervision of the secretary of state, who shall prior to
4 the next session of the legislature cause all the facili-
5 ties for carrying these resolves into effect to be season-
6 ably prepared, and shall after the adjournment of each
7 session, cause the acts and resolves passed at such
8 session, to be separately bound and deposited in his
9 office in the manner herein directed.

Resolved, That all acts and resolves or parts thereof,
2 inconsistent with the provisions of this resolve are
3 hereby repealed.
