IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX.

AN ACT in relation to repairs of roads in unincorporated townships.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. That the expenses for repairing roads in  
2 unincorporated townships shall be assessed by the  
3 county commissioners in like manner as is now pro-  
4 vided by law for opening and making roads in said  
5 townships.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its approval  
2 by the governor.

## AMENDMENTS.

## A.

Amend by adding to section first the following words :

“ And such assessment shall be made whenever they  
2 shall have satisfactory evidence that such roads need  
3 repairs.” Adopted.

## B.

And said assessments, whether for making, opening  
2 or repairing, shall be made upon all lands benefitted by  
3 said road, whether said lands be located in the same  
4 township through which said road runs or not, but in  
5 case of benefits accruing from said road to lands situ-  
6 ated in more than one county, then the assessments  
7 shall be made by the joint action of the county com-  
8 missioners of said counties.
