IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX.

AN ACT to repeal chapter one hundred and fourteen of the public laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-two, relating to costs in court in certain cases.
