STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX.

AN ACT to authorize the city of Bath to erect a monument in memory of the deceased soldiers of that city.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The city council of the city of Bath is 2 hereby authorized to raise a sum of money not ex-3 ceeding five thousand dollars, for the purpose of erect-4 ing a suitable monument in memory of the soldiers of 5 that city who have sacrificed their lives in defence 6 of their country in the recent war; and the same may 7 be collected by taxation or otherwise, the same as 8 money raised for any other city purposes.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after 2 its approval by the governor.
