STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX.

AN ACT additional to chapter sixty-five of the revised statutes, relating to the distribution of estates real and personal, and of lands held in mortgage and taken on execution.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Where an executor or administrator has taken land
2 in execution for debt due the estate as provided for in
3 section twenty-two of said chapter, and such executor
4 or administrator is or shall be deceased without dis-
5 posing of the same, his executor or administrator may
6 be licensed by the judge of probate to sell and convey
7 the same, to carry into effect the trust whereby the
8 same is holden, or for any other purposes designated
9 by law.
