STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for the preservation of flags, guidons and war trophies deposited with the state.

WHEREAS, the regimental battle flags, guidons and

- 2 war trophies deposited in the State House for preser-
- 3 vation and safe keeping are liable to injury or loss by
- 4 being removed therefrom, and as these precious memo-
- 5 rials of the sacrifices and gallantry of the soldiers of
- 6 Maine should be safely preserved and carefully pro-
- 7 tected, be it therefore

Resolved, That from and after the passage of this

- 2 resolve no national or regimental flag or flags, guidons
- 3 or trophies of the war, therein deposited, shall be re-
- 4 moved upon any pretence whatever, except in case of
- 5 fire or other danger thereto, which may render such
- 6 removal necessary; and the governor and council are
- 7 hereby authorized to cause as soon as practicable a

- 8 historical record of each regiment, battalion and bat-
- 9 tery of Maine volunteers engaged in the service of the
- 10 United States during the late rebellion to be prepared,
- 11 suitably framed and suspended below the colors borne
- 12 in service by such regiments and batteries so depos-
- 13 ited or which may hereafter be deposited for preserva-
- 14 tion in the State House, and to audit accounts for
- 15 service and expense in preparing such records, and
- 16 allow payment therefor from any moneys in the state
- 17 treasury not otherwise appropriated.
