STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of an agricultural survey of some of the large tracts of unsettled lands in this state.

Resolved, That the governor is hereby authorized,

- 2 with the advice and consent of the council, to employ
- 3 two suitable persons to make an agricultural survey of
- 4 some of the large tracts of unsettled lands in this state,
- 5 in order that the agricultural and settling value of such
- 6 lands may be better known, and to enable such per-
- 7 sons as may wish to settle on any such lands to obtain
- 8 information of their character and to readily know
- 9 where to find the best localities, and to facilitate the
- 10 development of the agricultural and industrial resour-
- 11 ces of the state, and thus to aid to retain in Maine as
- 12 many as possible of those who would otherwise emi-
- 13 grate beyond the limits of the state. And said per-
- 14 sons shall make to the secretary of state frequent de-

15 tailed reports of the proceedings of the survey in order 16 that the people of the state may be kept informed of 17 its progress and results. And said persons shall be 18 allowed such reasonable compensation as the governor 19 and council shall determine, which compensation as 20 well as the other necessary expenses of said survey 21 shall be paid from the treasury of the state.
