STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX.

AN ACT to amend chapter fifty-one of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section twenty, of chapter fifty-one of

- 2 the revised statutes, is hereby stricken out, and the
- 3 following substituted therefor: Boards, with the words
- 4 "railroad crossing," distinctly painted thereon, on
- 5 each side, in letters plainly legible, are to be placed
- 6 at the side of a way where it is crossed by a railroad,
- 7 on a post or other structure, in such position as to be
- 8 easily seen by persons passing upon such way.
- Sect. 2. This act takes effect from and after its 2 approval by the governor.
