STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX.

AN ACT in relation to the running of trains on the Portland, Saco and Portsmouth Railroad.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The Portland, Saco and Portsmouth
- 2 Railroad Company, and enginemen in its service, are
- 3 hereby exempted from the duty of stopping regular
- 4 passenger trains arriving on time at the point of cross-
- 5 ing, upon said road, as required by the forty-eighth
- 6 section of the fifty-first chapter of the revised statutes,
- 7 when approaching the point near the south end of the
- 8 depot of the Portland and Kennebec Railroad Com-
- 9 pany in Portland, where the track of the last named
- 10 company running to its freight house intersects and

- 11 crosses the track of the former; none of the penalties
- 12 imposed by said forty-eighth section shall be incurred
- 13 by said company or its servants by omitting to stop
- 14 such trains when approaching the point aforesaid;
- 15 provided that nothing herein contained shall be con-
- 16 strued to confer on such trains any right of priority to
- 17 the use of the way over trains of the Portland and
- 18 Kennebec Railroad Company.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved 2 by the governor.
