STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX.

AN ACT to increase the fees of jurors, deputy sheriffs, witnesses and county commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

The fees of grand and trial jurors attending court or 2 before a sheriff on occasions prescribed by law, and of 3 deputy sheriffs when ordered to attend the supreme 4 judicial court, shall be two dollars per day for each 5 day's attendance ; the fees of witnesses attending in 6 the supreme judicial court, shall be one dollar and 7 fifty cents per day for each day's attendance ; and the 8 fees of each county commissioner shall be two dollars 9 and fifty cents per day, and in that proportion for part 10 of a day, while actually employed in the service of

11 the county, including the time necessarily spent in
12 making drafts or other labor, and exclusive of time
13 spent in travelling, instead of the several sums now
14 fixed by law for said fees.
