STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX.

AN ACT authorizing pensions for disabled soldiers and seamen.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Any person who has served in the army

- 2 or navy of the United States, in the "war of 1861,"
- 3 on the quota of Maine, and who has been disabled by
- 4 wounds or other injury received in said service and in
- 5 the line of duty, shall be entitled to a pension from
- 6 the State of Maine, not exceeding eight dollars (\$8)
- 7 per month.
- SECT. 2. The widow during widowhood, orphan
- 2 child or children under twelve years of age, of any

- 3 soldier or seaman deceased from injury or disease con-
- 4 tracted in the service while in the line of duty, shall
- 5 be entitled to the same pension as is provided in sec-
- 6 tion first of this act, provided that no more than eight
- 7 dollars per month be paid to one family.
 - Sect. 3. Any person or persons described in section
- 2 first and second, who are not residents of Maine, or
- 3 who by the pension received from the United States,
- 4 their own labor and resources, are able to obtain a
- 5 livelihood for themselves and those dependent on them,
- 6 shall not be entitled to the benefits of this act.
- Sect. 4. All applications shall be made to the
- 2 governor and council, who shall regulate the proof
- 3 required to entitle applicants to the benefits of this
- 4 act, and issue certificates therefor.
- Sect. 5. Upon the issue of said certificate, the
- 2 treasurer of the city, town or plantation, where the
- 3 pensioner resides, shall be notified thereof, and the
- 4 said treasurer shall pay quarterly from the treasury
- 5 of said city, town or plantation, to the pensioner, the
- 6 amount specified and for the time specified in said
- 7 certificate, take vouchers therefor, and the same shall
- 8 be reimbursed to the said treasurer from the treasury
- 9 of the state on application.
 - Sect. 6. The necessary blanks shall be issued by

- 2 the secretary of state to the clerks of cities, towns and
- 3 plantations, and the expenses incurred in printing and
- 4 distribution shall be paid from the treasury of the
- 5 state.
