STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVES in relation to equality of civil and political rights.

Resolved, That the grand result of a truly republican

- 2 government can never be fully attained until equality
- 3 of civil and political rights be permanently secured
- 4 irrespective of differences of race or color.

Resolved, That so long as the elective franchise shall

- 2 be denied or abridged in any state on account of race
- 3 or color, none therein of such race or color should be
- 4 included in the basis of representation of such state in
- 5 the congress of the United States, and we approve of
- 6 the efforts of the senators and representatives from this
- 7 state in the congress of the United States to secure
- 8 such an amendment of the constitution as would effect
- 9 this result, believing that the tendency, and hoping

- 10 that the ultimate effect of the amendment, if adopted,
- 11 will be to secure equality of political as well as of
- 12 civil rights for all.
