STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX.

AN ACT to amend chapter eighteen of the revised statutes relating to ways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

The last paragraph of section sixty-one of chapter 2 eighteen of the revised statutes is so amended as to 3 read as follows : “ If the life of any person is lost 4 through any such deficiency, the parties liable to keep 5 the same in repair, if they have reasonable notice of 6 such deficiency, shall be liable for the damages, to be 7 recovered by the executor or administrator of the de- 8 ceased, in an action of the case for the use of the 9 estate.”
