STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX.

AN ACT to amend chapter ninety-four of the revised statutes, relating to forcible entry and detainer and tenancier.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section two of said chapter, is hereby amended, by

- 2 striking out in the third line the word "when," and
- 3 inserting instead thereof the word "where," so that
 - 4 the first clause of said section shall read as follows:
 - 5 "A tenancy at will may be terminated by a written
 - 6 notice to quit, served on the tenant thirty days before
 - 7 the time named for its termination; but if no rent is
 - 8 due where a rent is payable, it shall not be terminated,
 - 9 except at the option of the tenant, until rent shall be-
- 10 come due.
