STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX.

AN ACT relating to guide posts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Towns shall erect and maintain within 2 their respective limits, guide posts at all crossings of 3 public highways, and where one public highway enters 4 another such way; and for any neglect herein, shall 5 be subject to indictment and fine not exceeding fifty 6 dollars.

SECT. 2. Section seventy-three of chapter eighteen. 2 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed.
