#### STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVES in relation to the assumption of the state and municipal war debts by the general government.

WHEREAS, the several states, cities and towns of the

- 2 loyal portion of the United States have incurred debts
- 3 more or less onerous in putting down the rebellion;
- 4 AND WHEREAS, it is just and right that these ex-
- 5 penses should be borne by the whole country; there-
- 6 fore,

Resolved, That it is the duty of congress to pass all

- 2 necessary laws for this purpose that the several states
- 3 and municipalities now burdened may be immediately
- 4 relieved.

Resolved, That our senators and representatives in

- 2 congress be requested to use their utmost endeavors to
- 3 accomplish this object.

Resolved, That a copy of these resolutions be fur-

- 2 nished to each senator and representative in congress
- 3 from this state.
