STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX.

AN ACT in relation to the jurisdiction of trial justices.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. All actions between parties residing in
- 2 the same county, returnable before any trial justice,
- 3 shall be commenced before some such disinterested jus-
- · 4 tice residing or holding his court in the town where one
 - 5 of the parties or his attorney or person summoned as
 - 6 trustee in such action has his residence, and if there is
 - 7 no such justice in, or holding his court in such town,
 - 8 then before some such justice, if any, in an adjoining
 - 9 town, otherwise before any such justice in the county.

Sect. 2. When the parties reside in different coun-

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- 2 ties, such actions may be commenced before any such
- 3 justice having his residence in the county where the
- 4 defendant resides; provided however, that all trustee
- 5 actions returnable before such justice shall be com-
- 6 menced before some such justice in the county where
- 7 the person summoned as trustee has his residence.
 - Sect. 3. Original writs in civil actions issued by
- 2 any trial justice may be made returnable before any
- 3 other trial justice therein named in the same county,
- 4 and shall have the same force and validity as though
- 5 signed by the trial justice before whom the same is
- 6 returnable.
 - SECT. 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with
- 2 the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.
