STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX.

AN ACT extending the time within which certain banks shall redeem their bills.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. In all cases where the liability of any
2 bank in this state to redeem its bills would expire in
3 the year eighteen hundred and sixty-six, but for the
4 provisions of this act, such liability shall be extended
5 until the first day of March, in the year eighteen hun-
6 dred and sixty-seven.

SECT. 2. The bank commissioners shall publish in
2 one or more newspapers nearest the place where a
3 bank is situated, and in such other newspapers as they

4 may see fit, a notice of the time when the liability of
5 such bank will cease for the redemption of its bills ;
6 said notice to be continued for three months next be-
7 fore the time named therefor.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
