#### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX.

AN ACT relative to the introduction of foreign paupers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

If a foreigner is brought into this state, by any con-2 veyance, by land or water, and becomes a public 3 charge, within six months thereafter, any town or city 4 incurring any expenses for his or her support, or 5 burial, may recover the amount of such expenses, in 6 an action of the case, of the corporation, or party, by 7 whose means the person was brought into the state; 8 *provided* that the party so liable, shall be notified as 9 soon as practicable, that if he thinks proper, he may 10 provide means of support, or removal.
