AMENDMENTS proposed to bill "an act to make valid the doings of cities, towns and plantations relating to bounties to and for volunteers and for other purposes."

"C."

PROPOSED BY MR. ABBOTT.

Amend by adding a new section, as follows :

SECT. 5. No contract for payment of usurious interest, as to such interest, is hereby made valid; and no contract for bounty by any town, or its agent, where the drafted man or substitute claiming the same, has not been employed in active military service, shall be made valid, until the same shall be confirmed by a vote of such town.

Amend amendment "C," by inserting before the word "vote," in the last line, the words, "two thirds."
