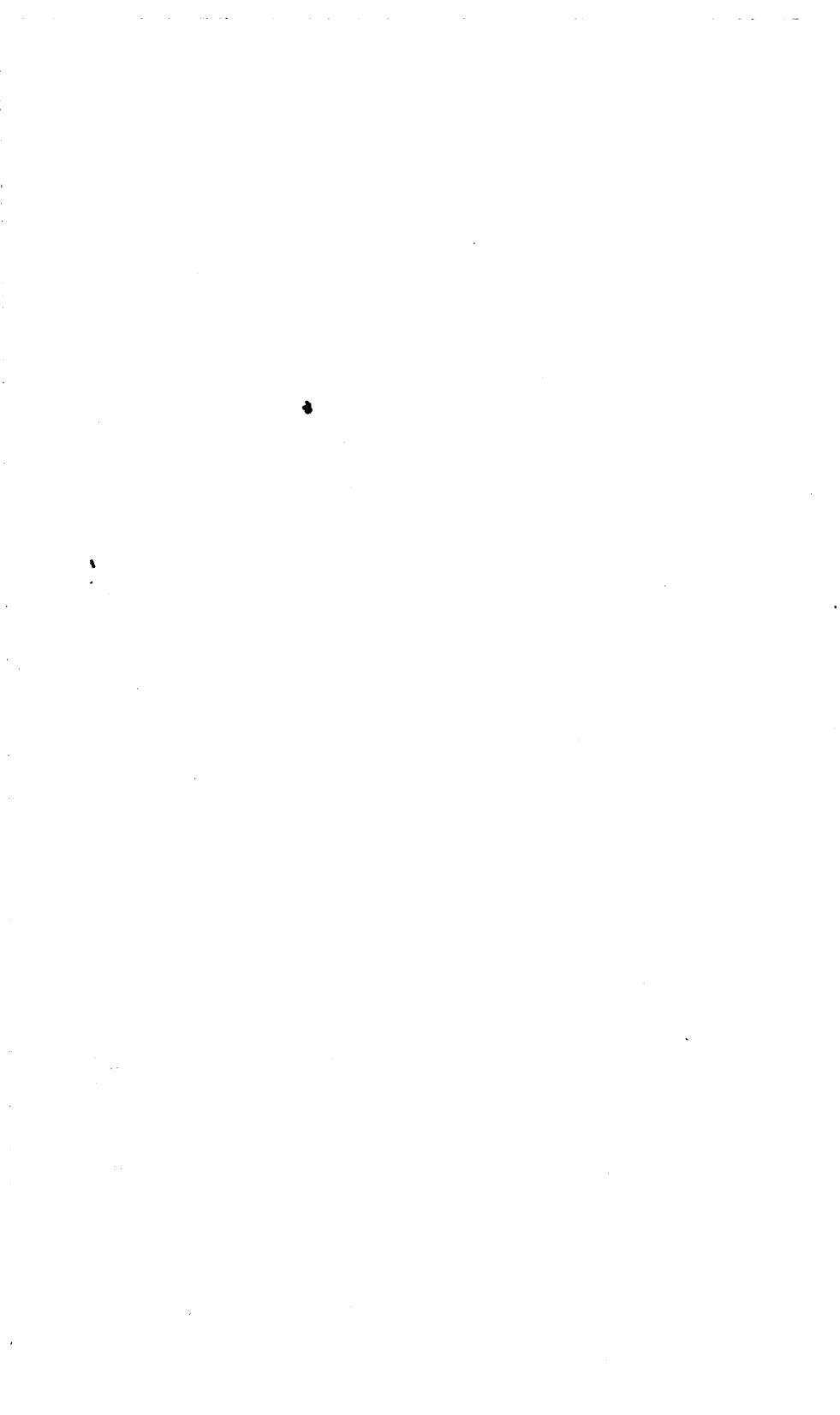
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to provide a mode of estimating and securing damages on the location of telegraph lines.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Whenever any telegraph company has been, or shall
2 hereafter be authorized to locate a line of telegraph in
3 this state, over or across the land of any individual or
4 corporation, the damages occasioned by such location,
5 in case the parties cannot agree, shall be estimated
6 and secured and paid in like manner as in case of
7 lands taken by railroad corporations, and the like rem-
8 edies are hereby given to parties interested or ag-
9 grieved by such taking or location.
