
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and ten of public laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-three, entitled "an act for the establishment of normal schools."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section six of chapter two hundred and ten of public 2 laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-three, entitled "an 3 act for the establishment of normal schools," is hereby 4 amended by inserting in the seventh line of said sec-5 tion after the word "dollar" the words "and fifty 6 cents," so that the last clause of said section as amen-7 ded shall read as follows : "Each pupil shall pay one 8 dollar and fifty cents for incidental expenses of the 9 school."
