STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter fifty of the laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-six, so as to allow county treasurers a fair and equitable compensation for services rendered under said statute.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section two, chapter fifty of the laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-six, entitled "an act relating to hawkers and pedlers," is hereby amended by inserting in the tenth line of said section after "treasury of the state," the following words:—excepting five per cent. thereof, which is hereby fixed as the compensation receivable by them for services rendered under this law.
